INCLUSION OF IMPORTER'S NAME AND ADDRESS ON PRODUCT LABELS.

INTRODUCTION

NAFDAC has issued a new directive requiring the inclusion of importers' names and address on product labels. This regulation aims to enhance transparency, accountability, and traceability of imported products in the Nigerian market.

KEY IMPLICATIONS FOR IMPORTERS

1. All product labels must now include the name of the importer.
2. This requirement applies to all imported products regulated by NAFDAC, including food, drugs, cosmetics, and medical devices.
3. Non-compliance may result in regulatory action, including product seizures and fines.

ACTIONS REQUIRED

To ensure compliance with this new regulation, we recommend that you:

- Review your product labels to ensure they meet the new requirements.
- Update your labeling process to include the name of the importer.
- Inform your suppliers or manufacturers of this new requirement.
